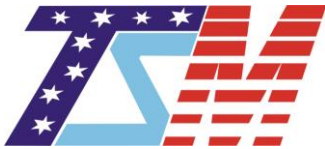

GRUNDTVIG – LIFELONG LEARNING PROGRAMME OF THE EUROPEAN UNION

The Department of Transatlantic and Media Studies (TSA) is participating in an international, innovative, media project supported by the European Commission in Brussels.

WHAT IS IT ABOUT?

COMAPP is a three year international project involving 7 partners who will cooperate in the production of media educational courses. The project explores innovative uses of information-communication mobile phone technology (the Internet, applications for audio recording, photos, music, geocaching and other forms of web interactivity) to create multimedia guides and other educational materials. TSA plans to introduce a new course into its “American Studies and Media” specialization curriculum, which will be available to other students at WSMiP, and which will utilize materials and the methodology worked out by the COMAPP international team of media theoreticians and practitioners.

WHO IS PARTICIPATING?

COMAPP Consortium of partners involves both university level institutions which have a long experience in media teaching and research (Germany, Poland, UK) and media practitioners who are actively involved in the production of media materials and in media broadcasting (Finland, Hungary, Spain).

WHAT ARE THE OUTCOMES?

Outcomes of the project will be handbooks, curricula, teaching and learning materials in 6 languages: English, Finnish, German, Hungarian, Polish, and Spanish. These materials will be freely downloadable from COMAPP website (<http://www.comapp-online.de>) upon the completion of the project. These outcomes will be pre-tested during training workshops and international seminars organized and sponsored by COMAPP.

THE FIRST EVENT

The first COMAPP event will be an international seminar organized by TSA in Łódź: May 6-10, 2012. During this event methodological issues and logistic solutions will be discussed and finalized and the first training sessions will be run.
